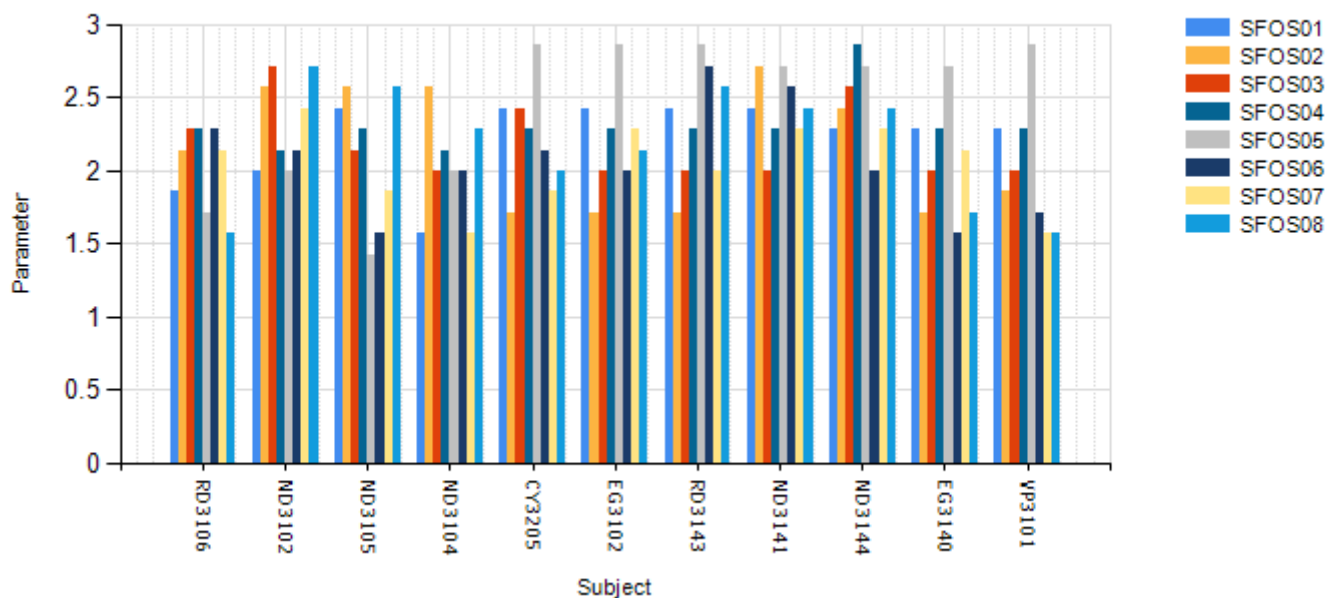

**Student Feedback Chart - 1st Semester**



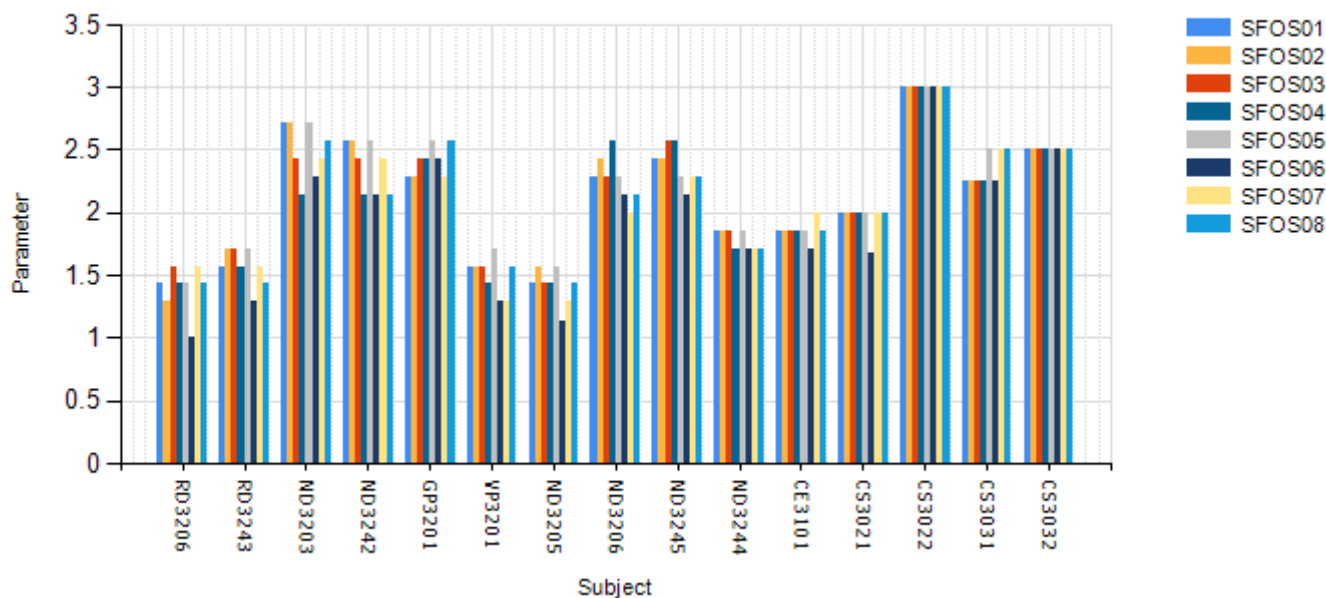

**Student Feedback Chart - 2nd Semester**



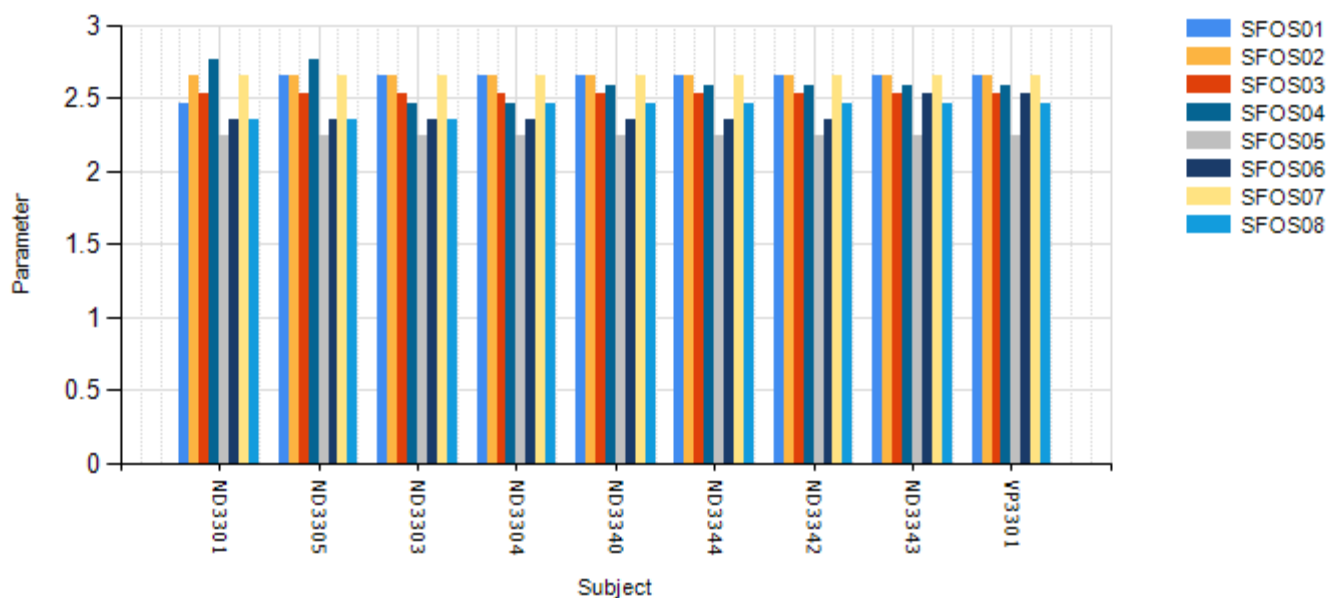

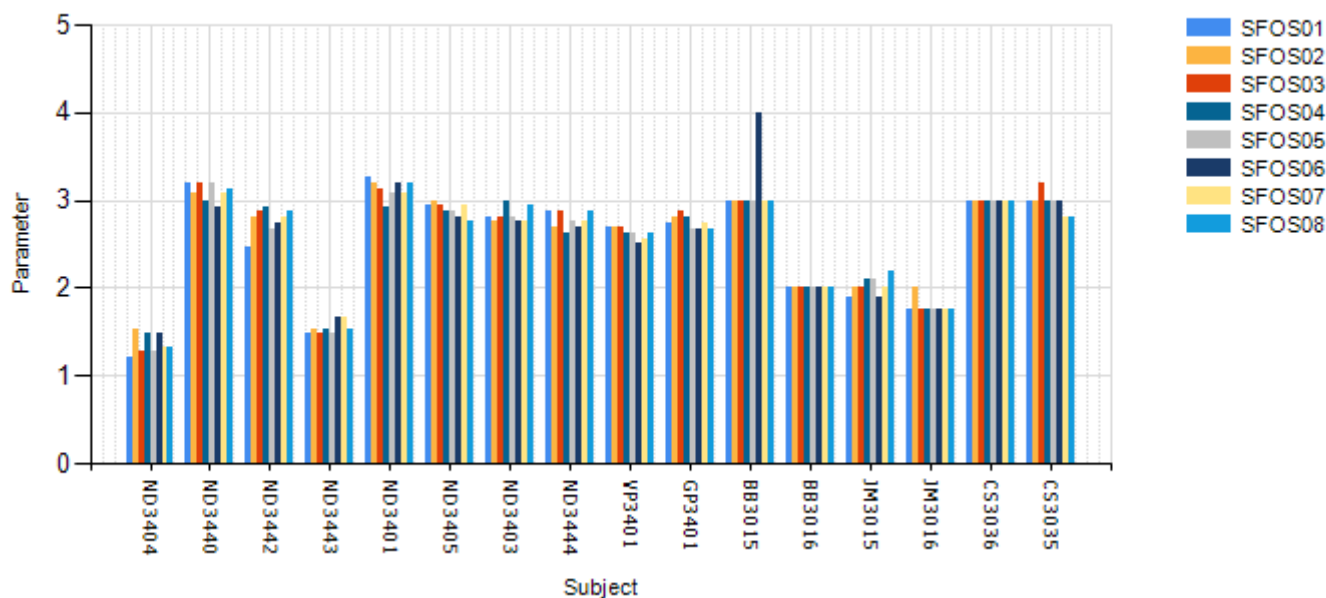

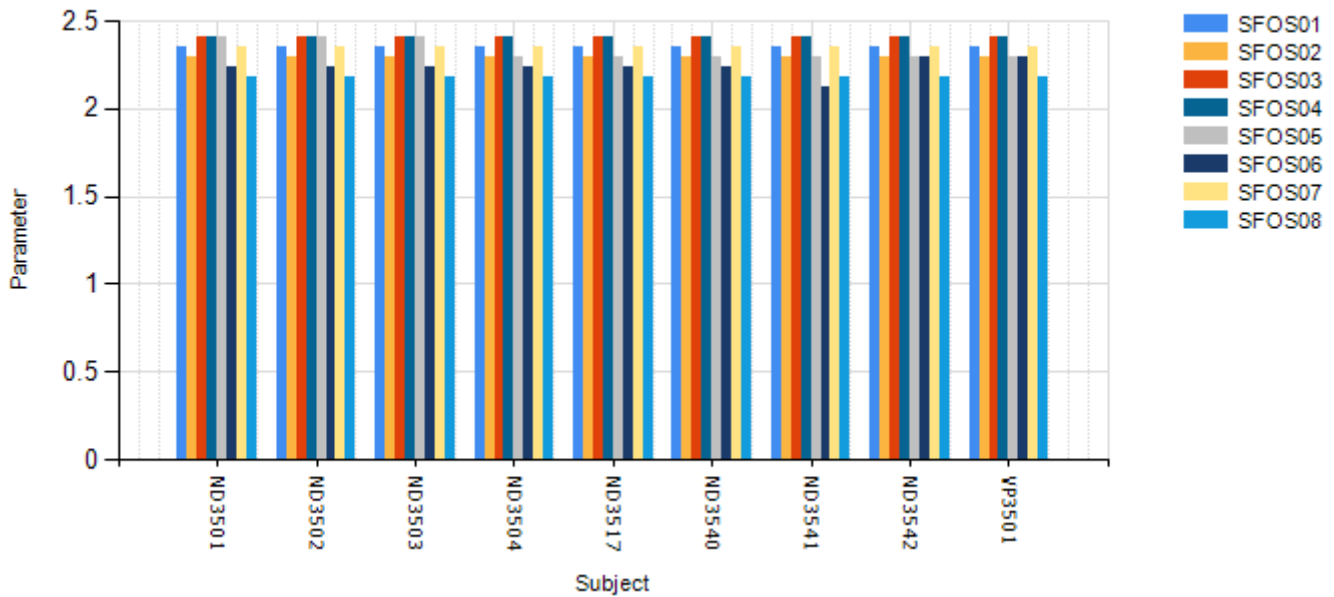

**Student Feedback Chart - 5th Semester**



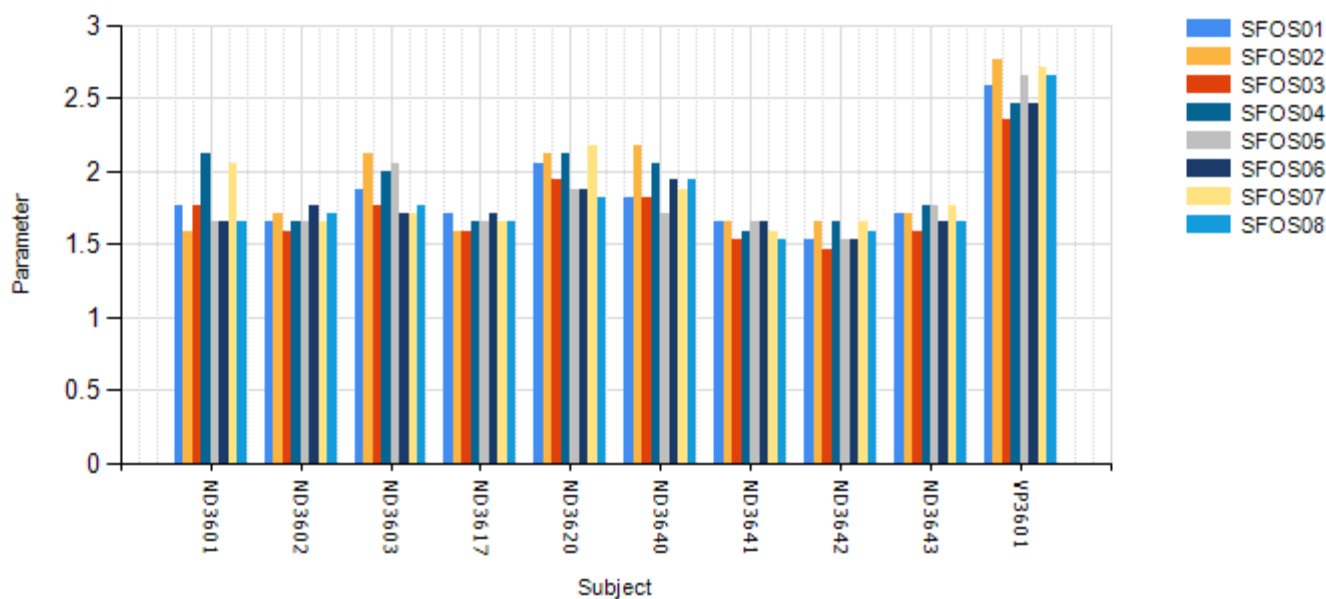
