Impact Analysis of Slow Learner in the department of media studies:

As per the evaluation of the Mid-Term examination conducted by the Department of Media Studies & Design 13 out of 23 Students of 1stSem have identified as slow learner in Bachelor of Arts (Hons) in Journalism and Mass Communication. Students who carry less than 40% Marks in different subjects in Mid-term examination was consider slow learner.

The department has taken the following steps to help slow learners do better overall:

- 1. Held the remedial classes (twice a week for three weeks) in accordance with the schedule listed below.
- 2. Offer educational resources on relevant topics.
- 3. Offer twice-weekly counselling sessions.
- 4. Library period of time.
- 5. Conducted tests each week after going over certain material.

Department conduct the remedial classes and covered important topics in various subjects. These sessions was designed to enhance your understanding and knowledge in your chosen fields of study. In addition to remedial classes, we had also be conducting focused sessions to cover key

Students who carry less than 40% Marks in different subjects in Mid-term examination has consider as slow learner.

To improve the overall performance of slow learner students, department has

- 1) Conducted remedial lessons (twice a week for three weeks) in accordance with the schedule provided below in order to enhance the overall
- 2) Performance of slow learners.
- 3) Offer study materials on relevant topics.
- 4) Offer twice-weekly counselling sessions.
- 5) Library period.
- 6) Administered tests each week after going over certain material
