In the following semester three mentor-mentee meetings were conducted. In those meetings mentor empathized with the problems of mentees and provided the best resolutions in theinterest of students and institution as a whole. The following agendas are detailed below:

### Agenda:

The first mentor-mentee meeting of the Department of Sciences, Quantum University, academic session 2021-22 was held on 4<sup>th</sup> March, 2022, venue B-103. The meeting was preceded by the mentorMr. Ajay Kumar Sharmaand 17 mentees, 03 of them were absent.

Mentees Akansha, Tiya Mehta and Vartika Chauhan discussedabout the inaccessibility of study materials and reference books in the library. Mentor forwarded this issue to the coordinator to get it resolved soon. Coordinator asked the library department to check the book-related concerns. Library administration department looked into the matter and soon after, all the required study

materials and reference books were made available as per the academic needs of the students. Hence, the problem was resolved in a couple of weeks.

Another problem was raised by Mahima Saini, Tiya Mehta and Vartika Chauhan. They complained about inadequate hostel amenities such as poor internet access and under maintenance of plumbing and electrical appliances. All such problems were escalated to the LMD Department and got resolved within a span of two to three days.

One more issue was discussed by Charchit Arya and Ayush Rawat on behalf of all students. They wanted to know the strategies for preparing general competitive exams. Mentor assured all students that in the upcoming year they will be provided with the lectures and resources to prepare for competitive exams. Besides, mentor added that the college has rich library resources for the aspirant.

The **Second meeting** was held on 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2022, venue B103, preceded by the mentor Mr. Ajay Kumar Sharma and 18mentees, 02 of them were absent.

Mentees: NishthaPandey, Akshita Verma, Gaurav Kumar and Kalpana Kumari on behalf of all students raised concerns regarding the cleanliness of washrooms specially girls' washrooms. Mentor brought up this matter during a discussion with the university's registrar, who promptly issued instructions to address the issue with the relevant authorities. Within a span of 3-4 days, the problem was successfully resolved. Subsequently, regular inspections were conducted to ensure the issue did not recur.

A personal problem was discussed by Pushpendra Gorsi who was unable to attend classes regularly due to father's illness. Initially, mentor contacted the student's parents to verify the matter, and then emphasized the importance of maintaining a minimum of 75% attendance as a mandatory requirement.

The first mentor-mentee meeting of the Department of Law, Quantum University, academic session 2021-22 was held on 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2021, venue Moot Court. The meeting was preceded by the mentor Mr. Arjun Bhardwaj and 18 mentees were present.

## Agenda:

In the First meeting, dated 08/10/21,16 mentees were present and two of them were absent, mentees: Mentees Aakash Saini, Ayesha, Ishani & Kajal wanted to know the about academics such as subject details, assignments, exams. Mentor informed all the mentees about the orientation program in which information related to academics, university processes and protocols would be extensively discussed. Mentor shared the schedule of orientation program with the mentees.

Mentees Sugam Gupta and Tanya Dhiman, have asked developed study skills. Mentor provided assistance to all the mentees about developing study skills like note-taking, test preparation and critical thinking approach.

Abdulla Iqbal Khan, Anamika Das, Sakshi Singh and Ishanihave shared their problems of not being able to balance between academic tasks and other co-curricular activities.
