

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



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## Introduction

The Examination Department at Quantum University operates in accordance with the University Academic Regulations. Its responsibilities include organizing examinations year-round, assessing student performance, and announcing results. This department is overseen by the Controller of Examination, who reports to the Vice Chancellor. At the beginning of each semester of academic session, an Examination Calendar is published to outline the examination schedule for the entire semester, covering End Semester, Sessional and Special Exams. The University adopts a Semester System for all its programs and adheres to CBCS and UGC guidelines for examination procedures. Additionally, for programs governed by statutory bodies like PCI, examinations are conducted in compliance with their respective regulations, which take precedence over other rules.

## Conduct of Examinations

Examinations are conducted as per the guidelines under exam manual approved in BOM.

The Examination Department issues the examination calendar at the beginning of each semester to ensure smooth examination procedures. Various aspects of the examination process are facilitated through the ERP system, including:

1. Candidate filling of examination forms.
2. Receipt of examination forms by the Registrar's office via ERP.
3. Generation of verification sheets and admit cards by the Registrar's office.
4. Uploading of date sheets and notices on the University ERP prior to the start of examinations.

In accordance with examination policies, flying squads are deployed to oversee the fair conduct of offline examinations. These squads conduct surprise inspections of examination halls to prevent any potential use of unfair means by candidates. Their objective is to ensure examinations are conducted in a fair, impartial, and orderly manner, maintaining the integrity of the examination process. Any discrepancies or deviations from regulations and guidelines

observed by the flying squads are reported to the Controller of Examination's office for further action.
