Zero Tolerance Against Anti-Ragging

THE ANTI-RAGGING CELL AT QUANTUM UNIVERSITY

- 1. Quantum University campus is ragging free and zero tolerance to ragging. To ensure the implementation of anti-ragging directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, Govt. of India, an anti-ragging squad and Proctorial Board is well constituted as per UGC norms and Hon'ble Supreme Court, Govt. of India guidelines to maintain strict discipline in campus in all aspects.
- 2. Formation of anti-ragging committee is defined. Discipline committee (Proctorial Board) is working as a support center. Discipline Committee (Proctorial Board) and Internal Complaints Committee will support the anti-ragging committee.
- 3. To ensure prompt response as per UGC norms and Hon'ble Supreme Court, Govt. of India, an anti-ragging control room is maintained in campus, with all the necessary facilities.

ANTI RAGGING POLICY

Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging

Ragging is a Criminal Offence as per the Supreme Court verdict. Ragging is an offence under Penal Code and under Section 116 which defines as: "Causing, inducing, compelling or forcing a student, whether by way of practical joke or otherwise, to do any act which detracts from human dignity or violates his/ her person or exposes him/ her to ridicule from doing any lawful act. By intimidating, wrongfully restraining, wrongfully confining, or injuring him or by using criminal force on him/her or by holding out to him/her any threat of intimidation, wrongful confinement, injury or the use of criminal force." "Ragging in all its forms is totally banned in this University including in its departments, constituent units, all its premises (Academic, Residential, Sports, Kiosks, Cafeteria & the like) whether located within the campus or outside and in all means of transportation of students whether public or private. The University shall take strict action including but not limited to criminal proceeding and/or cancellation of admission against those found guilty of ragging and/or of abetting ragging and the burden of proof shall hereby lie on the perpetrator of alleged ragging and not on the victim. An offence of ragging may be charged either on a written complaint by the affected or on independent findings of the Anti Ragging Squad. The University is bound by the U.G.C. Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009."






Formation of the Committee

The following points were discussed in the meeting:

- (1) To ensure the monitoring of instances of student ragging within the campus.
- (2) To raise awareness and educate incoming students about the serious repercussions of ragging.
- (3) The anti-ragging team should carry out unannounced inspections of the hostels caleteria, and other student gathering areas at least once dody for the initial three months after the admission of a new class, until birther instructions.
- (4) To enhance security measures in high-risk areas such as hostels, catetoria, gymnasium, library, and dining hall. Assigning night duties and floor responsibilities to both ACER and mon-ACER members respectively.
- (5) All department heads/coordinators should deliver talks on ragging to O(r) respective classes during orientation programs and the initial few sessions.
- (6) If parents witness any incidents of extreme violence, they should promptly notify the college administration.
- [7] All senior and junior students must sign the undertaking on the HGC anti-ragging website.
- (8) Organization of campus ambassador's formation to take place on the campus.
- (9) Stadents should be provided with a student handbook and joining natification to familiarize themselves with campus operations prior to their arrival.






Anti-Ragging Vigilance Duties




Purpose and Functions:








Reporting Mechanism:

The Grievance Redressal Cell at Quantum University serves the following key purposes:


Grievance Handling: Receives and addresses grievances from students, faculty, staff, and other stakeholders.


